- 1) Offer only applies to residences located within the boundaries of the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District
- 2) Must have official Tahoe Douglas Fire District Defensible Space Evaluation completed to be eligible.
- 3) To be eligible, homeowner must apply prior to replacing roof; homeowner must also comply with Addressing and vent screening components of official Tahoe Douglas Fire District Defensible Space Evaluation.
- 4) Homeowner must sign hold harmless agreement prior to any work being completed.
- 5) Homeowner must consent to allowing photographs of the project and to participating in any media events associated with this promotion. Any such materials will be solely the property of the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District.
- 6) Defensible Space work is limited to one nine hour day of work by the Tahoe Douglas Fire District Fuel Reduction crew, crew size is three persons.
- 7) Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District will not pay for any additional work associated with this program, including but not limited to roof work, crane work, tractor work, landscaping, stump grinding and disposal of materials. The Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District and its designee retain the right to determine the extent and quantity of any and all work associated with this program.
- 8) Tree removal will generally be limited to removing small diameter trees not immediately adjacent to the residence, limbing trees, removing brush, and moving combustible materials away from the residence. The roots of trees, shrubs and brush that are removed will be left in place. No work will be completed that is beyond the capabilities of the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District Fuels Reduction crew. The Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District retains the right to determine the capabilities of the fuels reduction crew.
- 9) Homeowner is responsible for obtaining a tree removal permit.
- 10) Scheduling of defensible space work will be discretion of the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District.
- 11) This services outlined in this offer will be awarded based upon a first come-first served basis to those who have complied with the terms of this promotion. Program is subject to available funds.

The Applicant, for him/her/itself, his/hers/its contractors, and employees, agrees to save, indemnify, and to hold harmless the TDFPD or its representatives from all liabilities and claims for damage by reason of injury or death to any person or persons, or damage to property from any cause whatsoever while in, upon, or in any way connected with the work covered by this promotion and subsequent work, and does further agree to defend the TDFPD in any claim arising out of or as a result of the work done under this agreement. Applicant agrees to allow subsequent access to said property for purposes of quality assurance evaluation, publicity events and/or compliance with terms of promotion and tree removal permit.
